For Our Prayers This Week

- 1. "Live simply so that others may simply live." Are we using our resources generously as good stewards, so that others who are not so blessed can simply live? Pray that we will not just feel sorry for, but give generously towards the needs of the poor, the homeless and starving everywhere.
- CBC needs to focus on evangelism and discipleship, without which she will not grow in quality or quantity. Pray that God will raise a team from within to drive these two critical areas.
- 3. Youths: Pray that God will bring more youths and young adults to CBC, that they will develop a sense of Biblical discernment for decision-making in godly living.
- 4. Pray for Amy Goh who will be having day surgery on Mon 20 Sept to remove 2 lumps (one on left shoulder and one on her foot): that the surgery will improve her ability to walk comfortably.
- 5. COVID SG: case numbers climbed to 804 this week, 238 who are above 60 years old, total 822 are in hospital. New clusters in a Madrassah, 2 nursing homes and dormitory. Pray that locals will avoid social gatherings these next few weeks so cases will decrease quickly, and that God's protection will be upon SG as well as many other countries, for example, India 27,000 cases per day, Malaysia 15,600 new cases, total now over 2 million. In China,80 new cases in Fujian province, nationwide 4,600 deaths. Pray for healing for those who are ill
- Tensions on the Korean Peninsula have increased this past week as North and South Korea launched missile tests.
 Pray that such "sabre-rattling" will not result in senseless war.
